# Browse

To browse the IOP electronic journals, click on **Journal list** option from navigation bar as shown below:

□ Use the alphabetical listing of journals by clicking on the first letter of the journal name to go to a list of journals starting with that letter **or** Use the **Category List of** 

**Journals** to select a category of interest. Titles are listed alphabetically within the category.

□ Choose a journal name to view the available volumes and issues. The number of issues that you see for each title depends upon your institution's electronic subscriptions.

□ Select an issue to go to the table of contents, from which you can link to the bibliographic page and the full text of the article.



# Quick Search

#### It's easy to search your Science Direct

1. Go to the **Simple** Search Form by selecting **Search** from the navigation bar.

2. Enter a word or words that describe the concept in which you are interested into the Text box.

3. Select a field or use the default to search any field.

You can also perform a **Quick Search** from any of the journal tables of contents pages by using the context-sensitive search box and pull down menu(s) located at the top of each page.

#### Title, abstract, keywords Field

Searches the title, abstract, and keywords fields of a document

#### Journal/Book Title Field

Searches for a specific journal or book title.

This field returns either articles or journal and book titles depending on which Quick Search fields are populated:

**Articles**: If search terms are entered in the other Quick Search fields (including the Journal/book title field), the search will return articles

**For Example**: Entering Title, abstract, keywords: dopamine and Journal/book title: neuro will return articles with "dopamine" in the title, abstract, or keywords fields and with "neuro" in the journal or book title.

**Journal and book titles**: If search terms are available only in the Journal/book title field, the search will return journal/book titles.

For Example: Entering only neuro in the Journal/book title field will return journals and books with "neuro" in the journal or book title, including:

- Neurobiology of Aging
- Neurocomputing
- Pediatric Neurology

**Searching a specific journal or book:** When the text --This Journal/Book-displays in the Journal/book title search field and you are on a journal or book home page, entering search terms in the other Quick Search fields will search only articles in that journal or book.

**Author Field:** Searches for documents written by an author. Quick Search will find results where both search terms are present in the document even if they are in separate author fields.

For Example: Searching for J Smith using Quick Search would find results such as: J.S Smith, J. Rolf.

To find authors where all your search terms are in the same field, use the Specific Author field on the advanced search form or the Specific-Author field on the Expert search form.

**Volume**: Searches for documents in a specific volume of a journal or book. For Example: Entering Volume: **34** will return documents with a volume number of "34".

**Issue**: Searches for documents in a specific issue of a journal or book. For Example: Entering Issue: **4** will return documents with an issue identifier of "4".

**Page**: Searches for documents with specific page numbers. For Example: Entering Page: **9** will return documents with page numbers, such as:

- 1-9
- 9
- 9-16

Entering Page: v will return documents with page numbers, such as:

- V
- v-xii

**Search Term(s)**: You can search any title/journals by entering any word/phrases in the above term(s) box. For Example: Genetics

#### Searching Multiple Fields

When you enter search terms in multiple fields an 'AND' connector is automatically included in your search query.

For Example: If you enter Author: smith and Volume: 4, your search will be for articles that have "Smith" in their author field and that have "4" in their volume field.

#### **Multiple Terms**

If you enter multiple terms in the Title, abstract, keywords field, Quick Search will include an 'AND' connector in your search query.

For Example: If you enter heart attack oxygen, your search will be for articles with "heart AND attack AND oxygen" in the abstract, article title, or keyword fields

**Exact Phrases**: To search for a matching or exact phrase in the Title, abstract, keywords field, you must enclose the term in quotation ("") marks or brackets ({}).

For Example: If you want to locate occurrences of the phrase "heart attack", you would enter "heart attack" in the Title, abstract, keywords field.



#### Performing an Expert All Sources Search

From the All Sources Expert search form, you can search all subscribed journals and books using Boolean syntax.

#### Alerts and Save Searches

You can save your search as an Alert when you want to be notified of relevant new articles by email. Alerts are available for username / password authenticated systems.

• To create Alerts, just click Save Search from any search results page.

• Save as many Alerts as you need, and schedule them to run daily, weekly or monthly.

• Emailed Alerts are HTML-enabled which allow you to link directly from the emailed Alert to the full-text article.

• You can easily run, edit, or delete any of your Alerts by using the linked commands that appear directly under the descriptive search information. Your Alerts are available to you for as long as you need them – until you choose to delete the information.
